

# **Helmet Pattern for Soldier Doll**

Pattern designed and provided by Penny Lee Stewart, <u>pennybiz@yahoo.com</u> (Beginner Level)



**Size:** Fits doll with approx 7.5 inch circumference head, when done with a 3.5 mm "E" hook and worsted weight yarn (#4). Use camouflage, Khaki, army green, etc.

MR = magic ring
BLO = back loop only
sc = single crochet
ss = Slip stitch
Inc = Increase
Dec = Decrease
R = Round or Row
ch = Chain
sts - stitches
\_\_\_ x = number of times to repeat what is
in {brackets}

**NOTE:** Helmet is crocheted in continuous rounds. Do not join. Use stitch markers or yarn to mark rows.

## **Directions:**

### **HELMET**

R1: 6 Sc in MR = (6 sts)

R2: inc in each st around = (12 sts)

R3:  $\{sc1, inc\} 6x = (18 sts)$ 

R4:  $\{sc2, inc\} 6x = (24 sts)$ 

R5:  $\{sc3, inc\}$  6x = (30 sts)

R6:  $\{sc14, inc\} \times 2 = (32 sts)$ 

R7-10: sc around for 4 rows = (32 sts) ss in next st, fasten off and leave a long piece of yarn to sew the helmet to head.

### Chin Strap:

Ch15. Look at the picture for the placement of the strap.

## Assembly:

Attach ends of chin strap to the helmet after securing the helmet on head.
