- Maintain physical conditions of all organizational facilities, grounds, and equipment including warehouse, headquarters office spaces, company vehicles, and warehouse equipment
- Manage building and equipment maintenance schedules and coordinate responses to urgent maintenance calls. Coordinate preventative maintenance, required repair, and testing, for all organizational equipment used by the staff and volunteers. Coordinate life cycle replacement plan for equipment as required
- Liaising with vendors and suppliers on behalf of the Operation Gratitude leadership
- Documenting processes and keeping maintenance records
- Monitor maintenance budget spending
- Lead and manage facility warehouse operations
